

Your child may have been exposed and is therefore considered a **close contact** for 10 days from this notification. Students should not attend school if feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of COVID-19. As a potential close contact, the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) strongly recommends your child(ren) take a rapid antigen self-test, which are <u>readily available</u> to families across the province.

The <u>Public Health Order</u> permits students who are close contacts to continue to attend school if they do not display any symptoms regardless of vaccination status. Unvaccinated students are required to self-isolate at all other times other than when at school (or on the bus to/from school) or childcare/daycare.

The requirements for close contacts are outlines in the graphic below:
