Dear Parent/Guardian:

A case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual at Scott Collegiate. We are working closely with Public Health staff to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all students. The virus spreads from person to person by large, respiratory droplets, like from a cough or sneeze.

Your child is considered a non-close contact and is not required to self-isolate, however they should self-monitor for symptoms.

Public Health will not be contacting individual parents/guardians of students, visitors, or volunteer contacts in the school.

We remind everyone entering schools to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Refer to the Daily Self-Assessment Checklist. Please complete this before attending school each day.

If you/your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, please call HealthLine at 811 and remain at home. If medical attention is required, please call ahead to your health care provider. If it is an emergency requiring urgent attention, call 911.
